Dear Warden Ostrander and Members of Council,

We continue to be grateful for the commitment of the County of Northumberland in support of the Northumberland Hills Hospital Foundation's Exceptional Community, Exceptional Care Campaign. The campaign has progressed well, and I am pleased to share this fall we will bring it to a conclusion.

The County's first instalment on its \$937,500 pledge helped to make the purchase of two portable x-ray units a reality. Your second instalment of \$187,500 received in November 2023 was invested in a significant upgrade to the Hospital's cardiac monitoring capabilities. This upgrade totalled \$783,779.

Cardiac monitoring is a non-invasive process for continuous or intermittent monitoring of heart activity. The data collected helps to predict heart disease or issues of the heart allowing practitioners to determine the appropriate course of action.

Our communities are growing and so too is the demand on Hospital's services. This growth necessitated an expansion of the Hospital's Intensive Care Unit (ICU) to add an additional five (5) beds. The bedside monitors for these additional beds were funded with your support. By investing in cardiac monitoring, we were able to upgrade our existing monitoring capabilities, while increasing our ability to monitor both in the patient care units and remotely for practitioners not physically present on the unit.
