Legal Work Streams

There are two distinct legal work streams to implement the Project:

1. Municipality Requirements

- a) Federal/Provincial Funding Requirement
- b) Northumberland Corporate Structure


2. Public/Private Partnership Requirements

- a) Broadband Project Corporate Structure
- b) Northumberland-Ontario Broadband Network (DIG/Merdiam) Commercial Agreements




1b) Northumberland Corporate Structure

- The Municipal Act authorizes municipalities to create Municipal Service Corporations (MSCs) to own and implement various municipal works and services
- MSCs have been used for a broad range of municipal projects including telecommunications, water & waste water infrastructure renewal, new hospitals and affordable housing
- We are recommending the creation of two MSCs for the Project: a parent MSC (the holding company) and a subsidiary MSC (which holds ownership in the Project)

Notes

- Special Purpose General Partner, an Ontario corporation, owned 92% by OBN GP and 8% by Intelligent Northumberland Inc.
- Special Purpose Limited Partnership, an Ontario limited partnership (92% of distributions to OBN GP, as operating general partner and 8% of distributions to Intelligent Northumberland Inc. as participating interest pursuant to the terms of a convertible debenture)



Next Steps

- Incorporate Municipal Service Corporations
 - File Articles of Incorporation for NCCDIC and MSC OPC and prepare other corporate documentation
- Approve the Northumberland NCCDIC Shareholders Agreement
 - Council appoints NCCDIC directors, directors pass other required Resolutions & corporate by-laws, etc.
- Negotiate & finalize various legal agreements with DIG/Meridiam
 - The GP Shareholder's Agreement & the LP Agreement based on the approved Term Sheets framework
 - Other commercial agreements will follow: Management Services Agreement, Construction Agreements, Fibre Wholesale Agreement, O&M Agreement, Credit Documents, Service Contracts
- Execute Federal Funding Agreement
