



By-law 28-2022

A By-Law to Prohibit Parking on portions of County Road 20 in the Town of Cobourg and on portions of County Road 50 in the Municipality of Trent Hills

Whereas Section 11 (3) of the Ontario Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 as amended provides that an upper tier municipality may pass by-laws, including parking and traffic on highways, within its jurisdiction.

Now Therefore Be It Enacted as a by-law of the Council of the Corporation of the County of Northumberland as follows:

Definitions

1. For the purpose of this By-Law:
 - a. **“County”** means the Corporation of the County of Northumberland;
 - b. **“equipment”** means an object that is towed or drawn by a vehicle or is propelled by or driven by a vehicle or any other kind of power including muscle power;
 - c. **“highway”** has the same meaning ascribed thereto in subsection 1(1) of the Highway Traffic Act, RSO 1990, c H.8 and includes a common or public highway, street, avenue, parkway, driveway, square, place, bridge, viaduct or trestle, designed and intended for, or used by, the general public for the passage of vehicles and includes the area between the lateral property lines thereof that form a right-of-way that is under the jurisdiction of the County of Northumberland;
 - d. **“park” or “parking”, “stand” or “standing”, “stop” or “stopping”** have the same meaning ascribed thereto in subsection 1(1) of the Highway Traffic Act, RSO 1990, c H.8
 - e. **“official sign”** means a sign approved by the County.

- f. “**vehicle**” includes a motor vehicle, traction engine, farm tractor, road-building machine and any vehicle or piece of equipment drawn, propelled or driven by any kind of power, including muscular power.

Prohibition

- 2. When official signs are appropriately erected and displayed on a highway under the County’s jurisdiction no person shall:
 - a. Park a vehicle on the highways or portions of highways set out in Schedule ‘A’ to this By-Law during the times indicated, with the locations set out in Schedule ‘A’ being designated as “No Parking Zones”
 - b. Stand, stop or park a vehicle on the highways or portions of highways set out in Schedule ‘B’ to this By-Law during the times indicated; with locations set out in Schedule ‘B’ being designated as “No Stopping Zones”

Exemptions

- 3. The provisions of this By-Law do not apply to the driver or operator of a vehicle that is so disabled while on a highway that it is impossible to avoid temporarily a contravention of the provisions.

Penalties

- 4. Any person who contravenes section 2 of this By-Law is guilty of an offence and is subject to the penalties and actions set out in subsections 170(14) and 170(15) Highway Traffic Act, RSO 1990, c H.8

That By-law 28-2022 be introduced and be deemed to be read a first, second and third time, passed, signed and sealed this 20th day of July, 2022.

Schedule 'A' to By-Law 28-2022 - No Parking Zones

Column 1 designates the highway on which parking is prohibited

Column 2 for clarity indicates the local municipality in which the highway is located

Column 3 designates the side or sides of the highway on which parking is prohibited

Column 4 designates the limits along the highway between which parking is prohibited

Column 5 designates the days of the week and time of day during which parking is prohibited

Schedule 'B' to By-Law 28-2022 - No Stopping Zones

Column 1 designates the highway on which parking, standing or stopping is prohibited

Column 2 for clarity indicates the local municipality and community in which the highway is located

Column 3 designates the side or sides of the highway on which parking, standing or stopping is prohibited

Column 4 designates the limits along the highway between which parking, standing or stopping is prohibited

Column 5 designates the days of the week and time of day during which parking, standing or stopping is prohibited
